### Forum Focus: Facilities Improvement Cornerstones

*Cazenovia 2030 And Beyond* is a long-range planning approach based on the following four “cornerstones” of facilities and educational program needs. Some potential items the District has begun to identify and plan for are included below, and will be topics for discussion and feedback at the Community Forum:

#### Life Safety & Security Upgrades

- Entry points, PA & cameras — continued integration of building security assets
- Replacement of deteriorated sidewalks and pavements
- Traffic safety improvements

#### Educational Space Enhancements

- Flexible education spaces in each school
- Specialized education spaces for high-needs students
- Providing real-world business experience for our students

#### Infrastructure Upgrades

- Roofing replacements
- Energy efficiency upgrades
- Relocation of greenhouse
- Floor and ceiling replacements

#### Fine Arts, Athletics & Community

- Auditorium sound & theatrical lighting upgrades
- Track resurfacing
- Playground improvements
