The Student Program Pass includes skiing/snowboarding on the pass day when Toggenburg is open and 3 weeks of lessons starting the first week in January.

On March 14, 2020 the passes convert to Season Passes for the remainder of the season.

Parents and even younger siblings may also purchase the Program Pass which includes 3 weeks of skiing/snowboarding and also turns into a Season Pass on March 14th. Those interested in the actual Friday Grade 3-7 Ski Club should click on the other link for paperwork.

Pass Policies: Refund and Rollover Policies, Management, Inherent Risk

Refunds:

Before the School Programs Begins:

- A person may receive a refund when moving out of the area. A letter indicating transfer from past or present employer is required for verification.
- A participant may receive a refund if unable to participate due to academic limitations or other sports commitments. A letter from the school is required for verification.
- A person may receive a refund if unable to ski due to a medical reason. A letter from a doctor is required for verification.
- A bookkeeping fee of \$25.00 will be deducted from the refund amount. ■ Please allow at least 30 days for a refund. **After the School Programs Starts:**

- A person may receive a prorated refund based on weeks used if unable to ski due to medical reasons only. A letter from the doctor is required for verification. The percentage of the refund is as follows:
 - a. Letter and pass received before the second week of the program: 5/6th refund
 - b. Letter and pass received before third week of the program: 4/6th refund
 - c. Letter and pass received before the fourth week of the program: 3/6th refund
 - d. Letter and pass received before the fifth week of the program: 2/6th refund
 - e. Letter and pass received before the sixth week of the program: 1/6th refund ■ A bookkeeping fee of \$25.00 will be deducted from the refund amount. ■ Please allow at least 30 days for a refund.

Rental Equipment:

- a. Before the second week of the program: 5/6th refund
- b. Before third week of the program: 4/6th refund
- c. Before the fourth week of the program: 3/6th refund
- d. Before the fifth week of the program: 2/6th refund
- e. Before the sixth week of the program: 1/6th refund

Rollover Policy

NOTE: Meal Plans are non-refundable and cannot be transferred to another season.

Before the Program Begins:

- A person may receive a rollover if unable to ski due to a medical reason. A letter from a doctor is required for verification.
- A participant may receive a rollover if unable to participate due to academic limitations or other sports commitments. A letter from the school is required for verification. ■ Please allow at least 30 days for a rollover. **After the Program Starts:**
- A person may receive a rollover if unable to ski due to medical reasons. A letter from a doctor is required for verification.
- A rollover request must be submitted with the program pass and required documentation before the 2nd week of the programs.
- Please allow at least 30 days for a rollover.

Management Policy

Management has the right to revoke any lift ticket, season pass or program pass for violation of any of our policies, rules or regulations. No refunds will be issued if management revokes your pass or ticket.

Inherent Risk

Our lifts require routine maintenance. We will not be responsible for grease damage to clothing due to grease from the lifts. This is an inherent risk to the sport. For more risks please refer to Article 18, page 15.

Cancellation Procedures and Additional Trip Options

We love the snowy weather but understand sometimes we may have programs cancel due to freezing temperatures or transportation issues. In the event that we do have to cancel programs due please refer to the following procedures:

Toggenburg Cancellation

Toggenburg Mountain reserves the right to cancel programs or close the ski area. Toggenburg will cancel in temperatures are harmful to the children. We generally do not cancel due to rain. We will contact you no later than noon on your scheduled day. Toggenburg will schedule a make-up time for lessons.

School Cancellation

When a cancellation is made by the school the Program Advisor should contact Toggenburg no later than noon on your scheduled day.

If the advisor cancels, but is not mandated by the school district or bus company, but Toggenburg remains open a make-up week of lessons is not offered.
