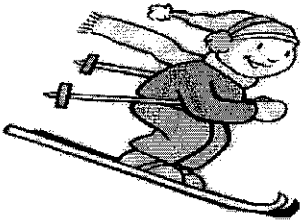


CAZENOVIA COMMUNITY SKI & SNOWBOARD CLUB

Grades 3-7

2019-2020 Winter Season



The Cazenovia Middle School Ski Club is for Cazenovia students in grades 3-7. It offers students an opportunity to ski with their friends on 6 consecutive Friday nights at Toggenburg beginning on January 4, 2019. Program dates: Jan. 3rd, 10th, 17th, 24th, 31st and Feb. 7th.



The club times are from 4:00-8:20pm. It is great fun for the kids and a nice option for parents. Many parents come out and enjoy meeting their kids on the hill, grabbing a bite at the Foggy Goggle or enjoying a few hours of "kid coverage" on a Friday night. The club is chaperoned each week at a minimum ratio of 1:10 and three Burton Street teachers will be chaperoning (Mrs. Burry, Mrs. Denton and Mrs. Cattadoris) along with the middle school nurse (Kathy Hudson) and several other community members. Please keep in mind that this is NOT an official CCSD club.

Safety is our top concern and we want all the kids to have fun and enjoy themselves! Please note that although chaperones are on site, this program cannot provide 1:1 coverage and students are not directly supervised at all times and must be trusted to make good decisions regarding their personal safety on the hill. The program DOES offer an avenue for students to ride to the hill together, have assistance with their gear and with locating their lesson groups and it provides adult eyes in the lodge and on the hill throughout the night. If you do not feel comfortable with your child's skiing ability or feel they lack the necessary level of independence, we encourage you to join them on the hill or wait a year.

PASS FEES: The fee for the program includes a pass good on Fridays for the entire ski season.

\$140.00 -Friday Pass with 4 weeks of lessons

Lessons dates: Jan 3rd, 10th, 17th, 24th

Friday passes are good any Friday after Jan 3rd and can be used EVERYDAY after March 14th!

TRANSPORTATION: During the six week program, transportation is provided to and from the hill for \$40. The bus leaves the Burton Street back parking lot promptly at 4pm and returns around 8:20pm. It is an option to sign your child out at Toggenburg if you would like to transport them home yourself. Please note that *students will not be released to anyone other than their parent* and they must be signed out by 7:45 or will be returned on the bus to Burton Street. This is a program policy, which will be strictly enforced. Please do not put advisors or chaperones in an awkward situation by requesting anything else. If you choose to drive your child to the hill, they may not ride back on the bus and will be considered your responsibility. Chaperones will only be responsible for the students that ride on the bus on Friday night. Students who cause a delay in the departure of the buses home will not be allowed to ride the next week.

Skis may not be transported on the school buses in the morning and there is no after-school care for students from the end of the school day until the ski bus leaves at 4. Please plan accordingly. Please bind skis and poles together as one unit. Also, any student with a full season pass may also ride the bus to Toggenburg as a member of the club for the \$40 transportation fee. Bus seating is limited and will be filled on a first come/first seated basis.

LESSONS: Optional one hour group lessons are offered as part of the ski club package. The first 4 lessons are free for students. Additional lessons can be purchased for \$15 per lesson. If lessons are missed, they cannot be made up at a later date. Students are asked to meet their instructor at the base of the hill by 4:55 as lessons start at 5pm. Please note your child's skill level on their registration form so that they can be placed in the correct lesson group.

RENTAL EQUIPMENT OPTION: If your child does not own his/her own equipment, Toggenburg has a prepaid, preset rental plan option for the six weeks program for \$120. Equipment will be reserved for students each week in the Rental Shop. The Rental Shop is highly organized and equipment is set out and labeled before we arrive. Prior to and after the six-week program period, ski and snowboard rentals will cost their regular fee.

FOOD/OPTIONAL MEAL PLAN: Students are encouraged to pack snacks, drinks and/or a meal. However, if you would like your child to be able to grab dinner at Toggenburg without the hassle of sending food/money along, the hill offers a 6x meal plan for Friday night ski club. If purchased, this program and the monies will be noted on their pass. **The fee is \$60 for the 6 weeks.** **However, it does come with a catch. The kids have to pick up all their items at once (main item, drink, fries).

Each meal is good for:

- 1.Choice of: hamburger, cheeseburger, hotdog, pizza, sandwich, or pre-packed wrap or salad
- 2.French Fries
- 3.Drink: small soda, white or chocolate milk

**Unfortunately, meal plans are non-refundable and cannot be transferred to another season.*

PHOTO ID: All pass holders will receive a photo ID upon registering for the Friday pass. Skiers and snowboarders must provide a small photo with their registration materials for this reason. Passes will be available for pick-up by mid-December at the Toggenburg ticket counter.

If passes are not picked up prior to our start date of January 4th, chaperones will have photo IDs for students the first time they arrive. **Students MUST have a pass in order to be on the slopes. A replacement fee of \$27 will be charged for a lost pass.**

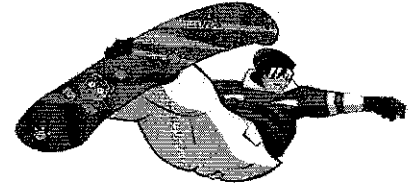
HELMETS: Helmets are not required by Toggenburg, but are HIGHLY recommended by Cazenovia 3-7 Ski Club. Please provide one for your child or rent one from the hill.

SAFETY: It is highly recommended that all participants become familiar with NYS Skier's Responsibilities, Article 18.

CANCELLATIONS: All reminders, updates, and cancellation information will be sent through email. Please include an email address on the registration form. Please note: If school is cancelled or closing early, the Cazenovia Community Ski & Snowboard Club will also be cancelled.

REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS:

Fill in all information on your registration forms. Registration forms with missing information will not be processed. Please be sure to sign the forms. Please note: parent and student signatures are required on the registration forms. Additional registration packets are available outside the Cazenovia Middle School office and Mrs. Burry's room at Burton Street. Submit the forms, photo and payment (one check payable to Toggenburg Ski Center and one check for \$40.00 payable to Cazenovia Transportation Dept.) to the main office at either Cazenovia Middle School or to Mrs. Burry/Denton at Burton Street.

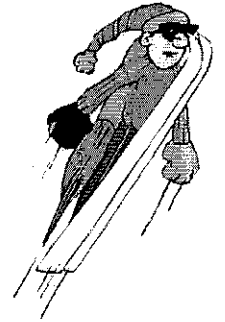

I give my son/daughter permission to ride the bus to and from Toggenburg Ski Center on Friday nights for six weeks. **I understand that if I transport my child to Toggenburg, I must also provide supervision and transportation home. I may only pick up my own child, by signing him/her out before 8:00 p.m. I understand that my child cannot be signed out by anyone other than myself.** We have discussed the importance of following all bus rules and regulations and the fact that advisors and chaperones have the authority to enforce all rules and regulations for safety purposes.

We understand that skiing & snowboarding are hazardous sports and injuries may occur. I agree to release the Cazenovia Central School District, its directors and its employees, as well as ski advisors and chaperones, from any and all liability related to any personal or property injury or loss connected with any aspect of this program.

I will attend ski/snowboard lessons if deemed necessary by my parent/guardian. I will ski/snowboard in control at all times and heed ski patrol suggestions and directions. I will ski/snowboard only in designated areas and observe all posted signs. I understand that a ski pass must be presented in order to ski/snowboard. Toggenburg does not issue temporary passes to students who have lost or forgotten their passes. If I forget my pass, I realize I must purchase a lift ticket, at full price, and/or pay a \$27 replacement fee that requires a one-week waiting period. Replacement passes must be purchased in the presence of a program advisor or chaperone. **All snowboarders and skiers are encouraged to wear a helmet.**

Although it is not a district sponsored program, the Community Ski Club follows the policies and procedures contained in the "Cazenovia Central Schools Extracurricular handbook for Students and Parents" We, the undersigned, have carefully read, understand, and agree to abide by the policies and procedures that are contained in the handbook. A copy of page 4 is included for your convenience. Any failure to abide by the rules may result in the loss of bus privileges without a refund. We also recognize that our signatures grant permission for our son/daughter to ski/snowboard at Toggenburg.

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Pass Policies: Refund and Rollover Policies, Management, Inherent Risk

Refunds:

Before the School Programs Begins:

- A person may receive a refund when moving out of the area. A letter indicating transfer from past or present employer is required for verification.
- A participant may receive a refund if unable to participate due to academic limitations or other sports commitments. A letter from the school is required for verification.
- A person may receive a refund if unable to ski due to a medical reason. A letter from a doctor is required for verification.
- A bookkeeping fee of \$25.00 will be deducted from the refund amount. 📅 Please allow at least 30 days for a refund. **After the School Programs Starts:**

- A person may receive a prorated refund based on weeks used if unable to ski due to medical reasons only. A letter from the doctor is required for verification. The percentage of the refund is as follows:
 - a. Letter and pass received before the second week of the program: 5/6th refund
 - b. Letter and pass received before third week of the program: 4/6th refund
 - c. Letter and pass received before the fourth week of the program: 3/6th refund
 - d. Letter and pass received before the fifth week of the program: 2/6th refund
 - e. Letter and pass received before the sixth week of the program: 1/6th refund 📅 A bookkeeping fee of \$25.00 will be deducted from the refund amount. 📅 Please allow at least 30 days for a refund.

Rental Equipment:

- a. Before the second week of the program: 5/6th refund
- b. Before third week of the program: 4/6th refund
- c. Before the fourth week of the program: 3/6th refund
- d. Before the fifth week of the program: 2/6th refund
- e. Before the sixth week of the program: 1/6th refund

Rollover Policy

NOTE: Meal Plans are non-refundable and cannot be transferred to another season.

Before the Program Begins:

- A person may receive a rollover if unable to ski due to a medical reason. A letter from a doctor is required for verification.
- A participant may receive a rollover if unable to participate due to academic limitations or other sports commitments. A letter from the school is required for verification. 📅 Please allow at least 30 days for a rollover. **After the Program Starts:**
- A person may receive a rollover if unable to ski due to medical reasons. A letter from a doctor is required for verification.
- A rollover request must be submitted with the program pass and required documentation before the 2nd week of the programs.
- Please allow at least 30 days for a rollover.

Management Policy

Management has the right to revoke any lift ticket, season pass or program pass for violation of any of our policies, rules or regulations. No refunds will be issued if management revokes your pass or ticket.

Inherent Risk

Our lifts require routine maintenance. We will not be responsible for grease damage to clothing due to grease from the lifts. This is an inherent risk to the sport. For more risks please refer to Article 18, page 15.

Cancellation Procedures and Additional Trip Options

We love the snowy weather but understand sometimes we may have programs cancel due to freezing temperatures or transportation issues. In the event that we do have to cancel programs due please refer to the following procedures:

Toggenburg Cancellation

Toggenburg Mountain reserves the right to cancel programs or close the ski area. Toggenburg will cancel in temperatures are harmful to the children. We generally do not cancel due to rain. We will contact you no later than noon on your scheduled day. Toggenburg will schedule a make-up time for lessons.

School Cancellation

When a cancellation is made by the school the Program Advisor should contact Toggenburg no later than noon on your scheduled day.

If the advisor cancels, but is not mandated by the school district or bus company, but Toggenburg remains open a make-up week of lessons is not offered.

Downhill skiing and boarding, as in other sports, contains inherent risks, including but not limited to the risk of personal injury, including catastrophic injury or death or property damage, which may be caused by variations in terrain or weather conditions or surface or subsurface snow, ice, bare spots or areas of thin cover, moguls, ruts bumps or other persons using the facilities; or rocks, branches, forest growth, debris, roots, stumps or other natural objects or man-made objects that are incidental to the provision or maintenance of skiing and boarding facility in New York State.
